2. Updated features

2.1. Business rules modifications

2.1.1. Activation with the vaccination web application

When a doctor activates a person in the vaccination web application, VCD stores the hospital nihii number to know which hospital has activated the vaccination code.

2.1.2. Reactivation by the reservation tool

The source "RESERVATION_TOOL" can now use the method "reactivate". This allows the reservation tool to reactivate vaccination codes for people who have inadvertently deactivated it.

2.1.3. List schedulable vaccinations

"CITIZENPRIO1" is added to the algorithm to return people by priority.

The priority algorithm is now :

1. Healthcare workers
2. MEDIPRIO1
3. Essential workers
4. People older than 70 years
5. 75% people from 65 to 69 years and 25% people with a comorbidity or with HOSPITAL as source
6. CITIZENPRIO1
7. People from 18 to 69 years

2.1.4. Activation by ssin

An extra source "CITIZENPRIO1" can now use this method to activate people.

The priority to update the "source" field is now the following :

1. COBRHA
2. MEDIPRIO1
3. REGION_ESSENTIAL_WORKER
4. GP / HOSPITAL
5. CIN_NIC
6. CITIZENPRIO1
7. RESERVATION_TOOL

The priority to update the "vaccineType" field is now the following :

1. GP / CIN_NIC / MEDIPRIO1 / HOSPITAL
2. COBRHA
3. REGION_ESSENTIAL_WORKER / CITIZENPRIO1
