2. Updated features

2.1. Business rules modifications

2.1.1. Automatic activation

VCD no longer activates codes automatically at creation because VCD may not activate people under 18.

2.1.2. Activate By Ssin

The minimum age for the activation has been changed from 18 to 16 years.

2.1.3. List Schedulable

The minimum age of the returned people has been changed from 18 to 16 years.

2.1.4. Last minute booking eligibility

People aged 16 and 17 are now eligible to the last minute booking if they have an activated vaccination code.

2.1.5. Free test eligibility

During the summer holidays, the citizens can do two free PCR tests to go on vacation, to participate in an event, ...

A free PCR test can be obtained twice if the following conditions are met :

1. the person to be tested is 6 years or older and
2. has his main residence in Belgium according to the information in the National Register and
3. has not already obtained a CTPC for a free test twice and (Verified by CTPC)
4. is in one of the following cases at the time of the request for a CTPC for a free test
 - a. the person has not been invited yet for vaccination and not been (partially) vaccinated yet
 - b. the person has been invited for vaccination no longer than 30 days ago
 - c. the person has received a first of two required doses-no longer than
 - i. 98 or 70 days ago for AstraZeneca, depending on whether the first dose was given before May 26 or May 26 onwards
 - ii. 49 days ago for Moderna
 - iii. 49 days ago for Pfizer
 - d. the person has received a dose of Johnson & Johnson no longer than 21 days ago.

To verify the eligibility to a free PCR test, a new method has been created. This method can only be called by the CTPC API.

If the citizen is not eligible, this method returns one of the three following errors translated in all languages (French, Dutch, English and German) :

- AGE_NOT_ALLOWED
 - You do not have the minimum age required to be able to get a free PCR test. It can be received by people from 6 years old.
- NO_ADDRESS_IN_BELGIUM
 - No valid Belgian address has been found.
- VACCINATION_STATUS_NOT_MET
 - Your vaccination status does not allow you to receive a free PCR test.

2.2. API modifications

2.2.1. OlderThan parameter

The limit of the parameter “OlderThan” in the methods “listSchedulable” and “bulkActivationByOldest” has been changed from 18 to 16.
